

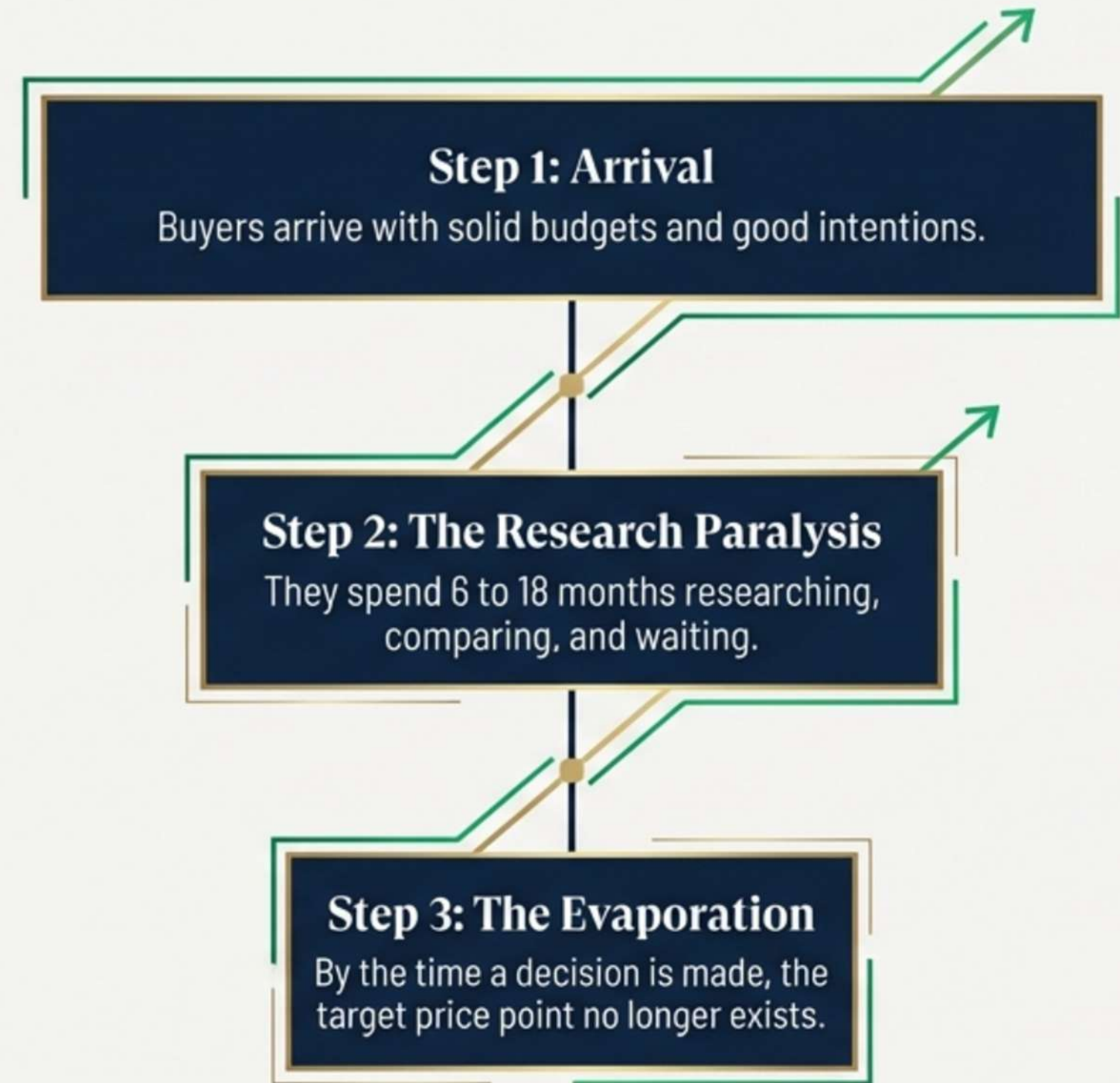

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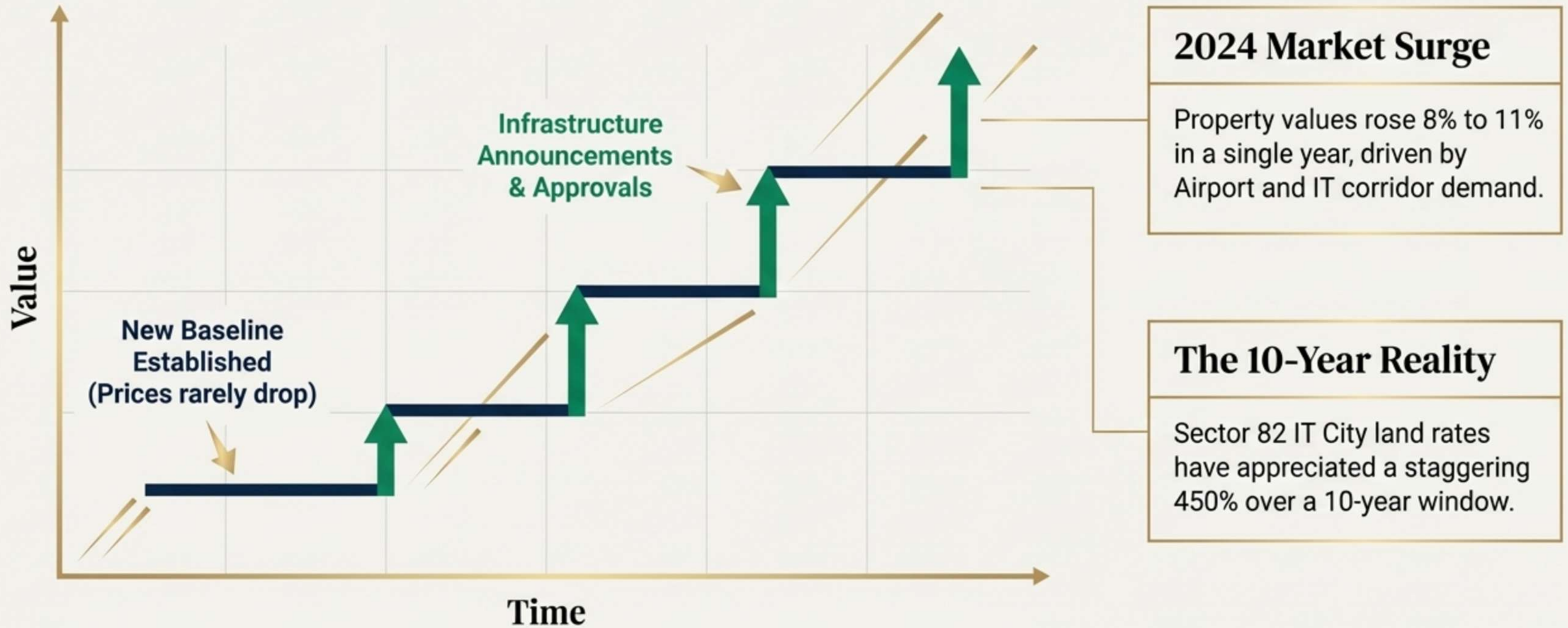

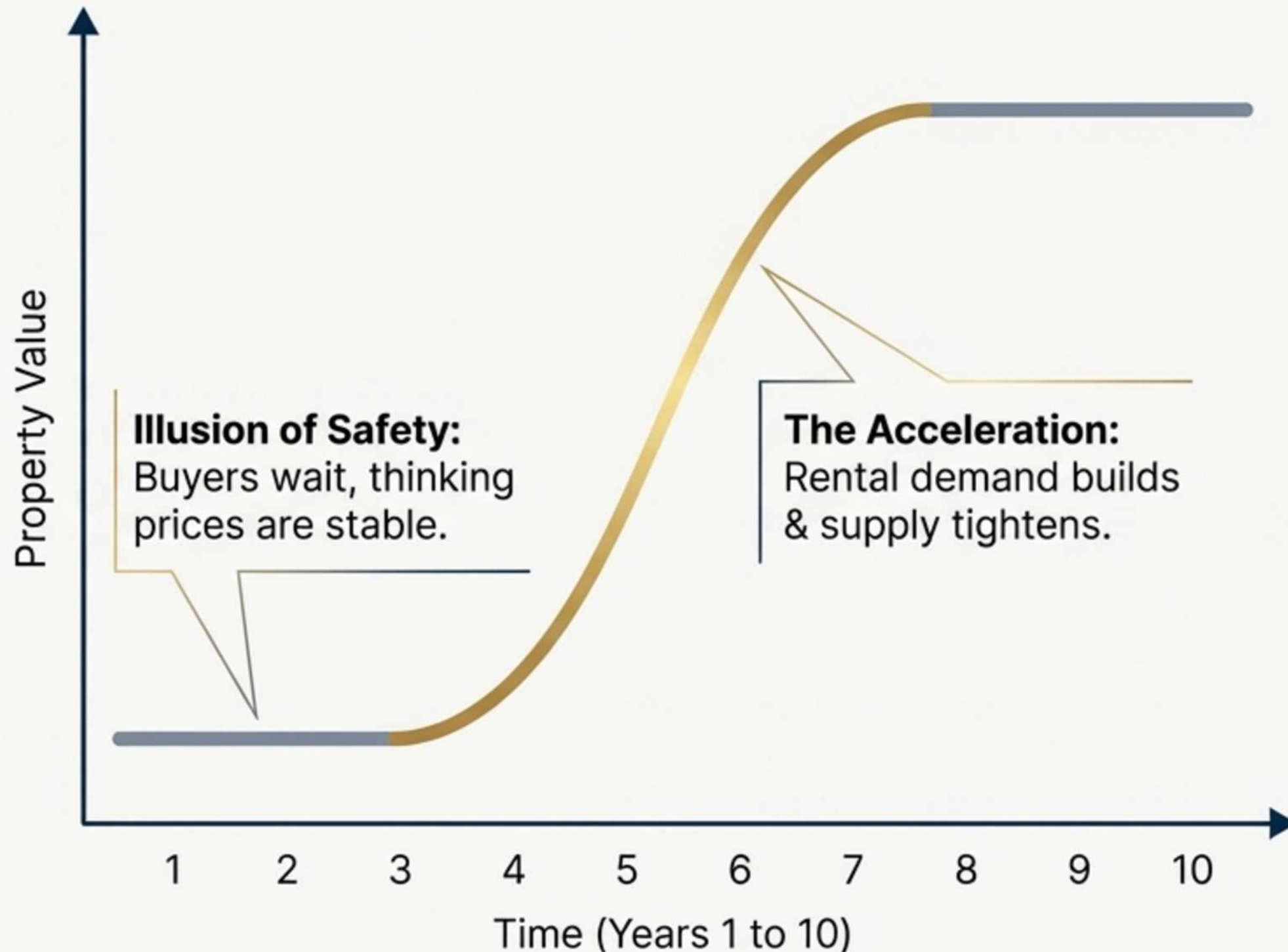
The Plot Story: Numbers That Change Everything

Location	5 Years Ago	Today (2026)	Appreciation
Sector 82, IT City	~₹28,000/sq yd	~₹1,48,000/sq yd	450% in 10 yrs
Aerocity Mohali	~₹21,000/sq yd	~₹1,26,000/sq yd	403% in 10 yrs
Airport Road	~₹22,000/sq yd	~₹1.40L/sq yd	455% in 10 yrs

This consistent pattern isn't limited to premium sectors. Emerging areas like Sector 108 and 109 have appreciated over **112%** in just 3 years.

The Rent Trap: A Real Calculation Nobody Does

In a 2BHK near IT City/Airport Road, rent jumped from ₹15k–18k in 2020 to ₹25k–35k in 2026. (A 55–70% increase in 5 years).

Three Critical Buyer Mistakes

Trap 1: Waiting for a Correction

I'll wait for prices to drop.

The Reality: Mohali has not seen a sustained price correction in 15 years. With Chandigarh locked out of new supply since 2016, structural demand prevents meaningful dips.

Trap 2: Anchoring to Past Prices

It was cheaper 12 months ago; it's too expensive now.

The Reality: This logic applied at every stage of Mohali's growth.

The relevant question is where prices were, but where they are going.

Trap 3: Wrong Stage, Right Sector

I must buy in the most established sector.

The Reality: Mature sectors appreciate 40–50% over 5 years.

Early-stage sectors of similar quality can deliver 100–150% on the exact same budget.

The Macro Context: The Chandigarh Gap

Chandigarh: Locked supply since 2016. Premium sector land trades at an immovable ₹2.37L/sq yd.

Mohali: Prime corridors currently trade at ₹1.25–1.50L/sq yd.
