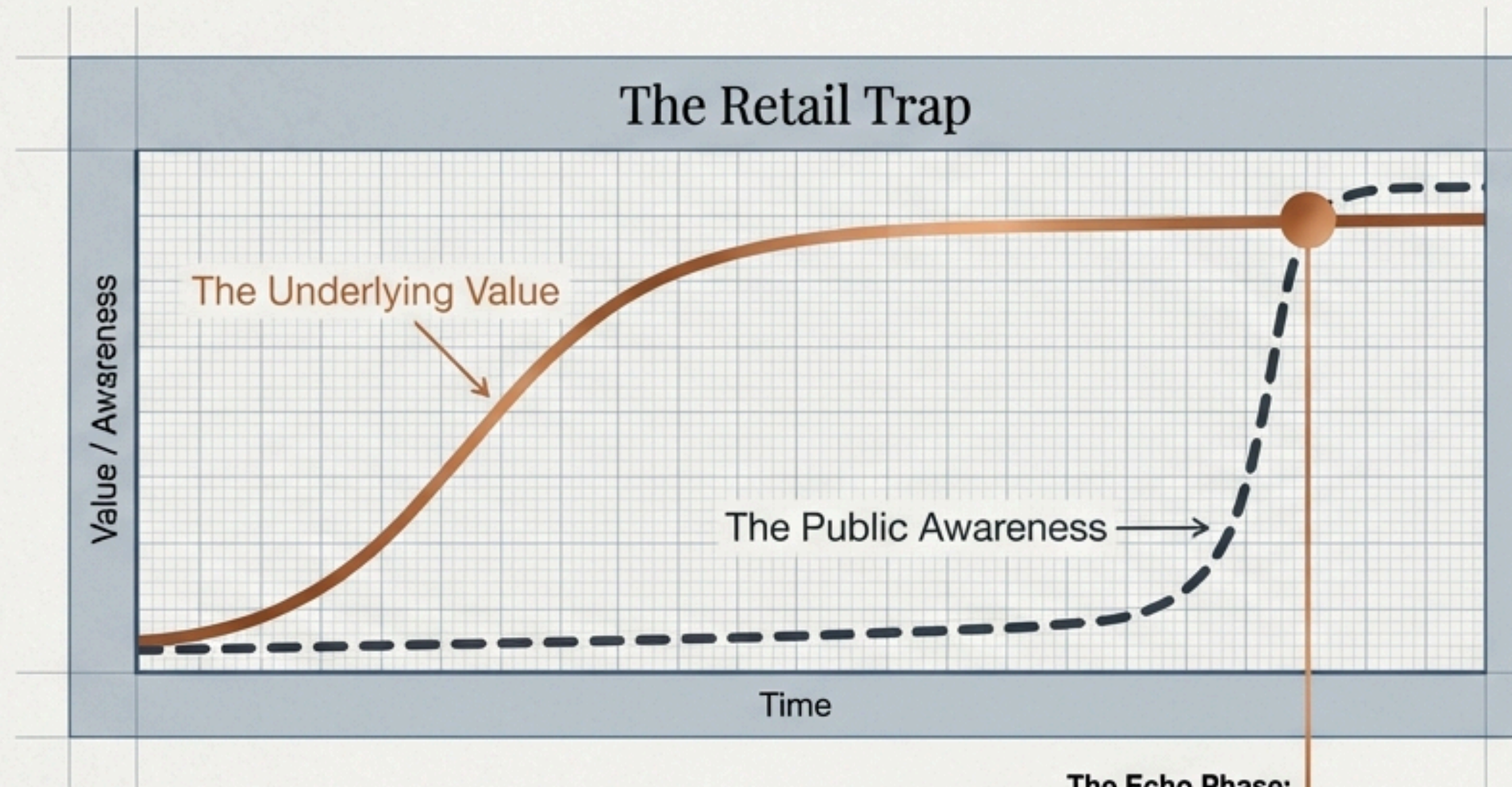

The Illusion of Market Timing

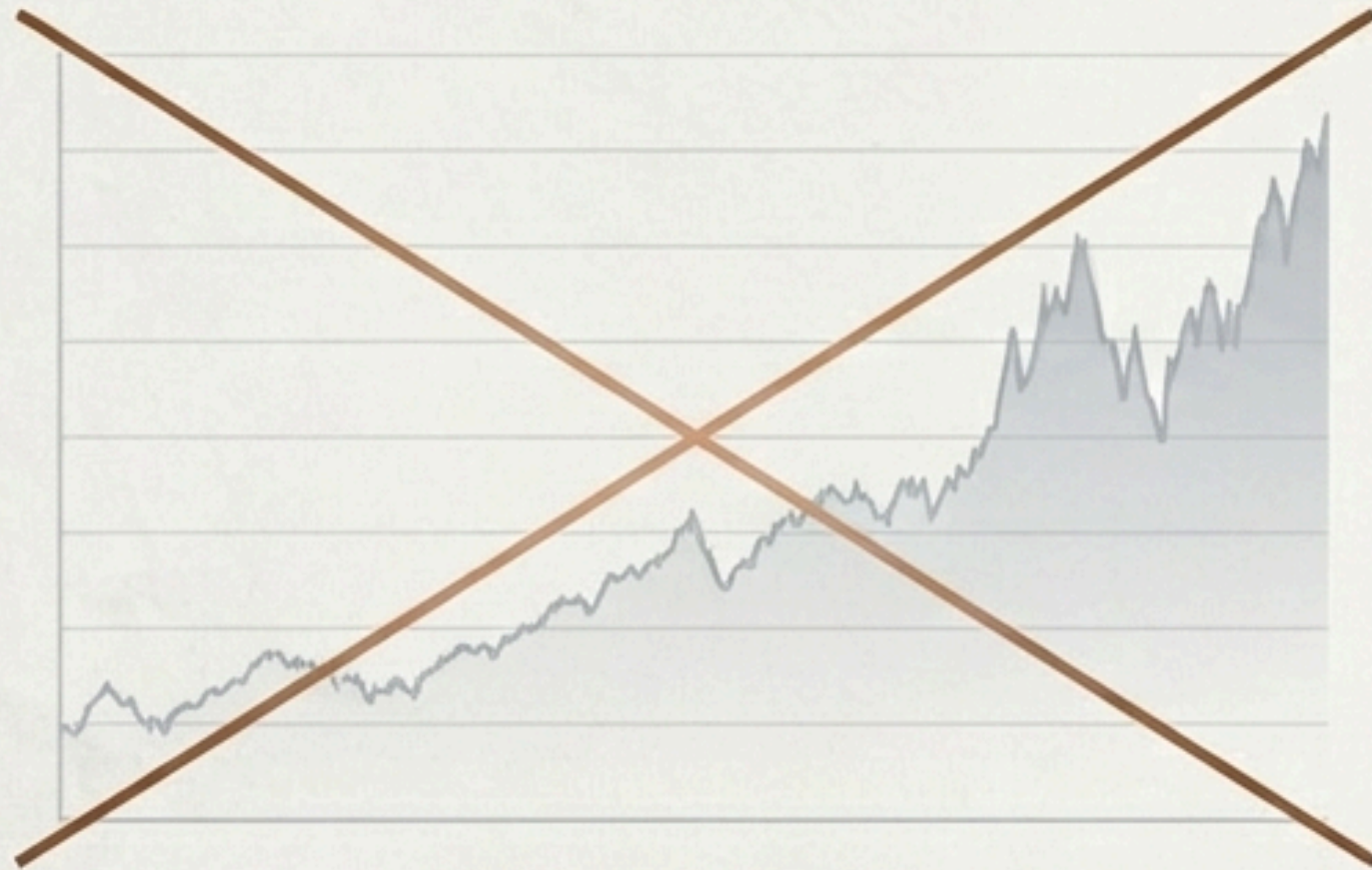
“By the time people say ‘prices are rising here,’ something important has already happened. And most buyers completely miss it.”



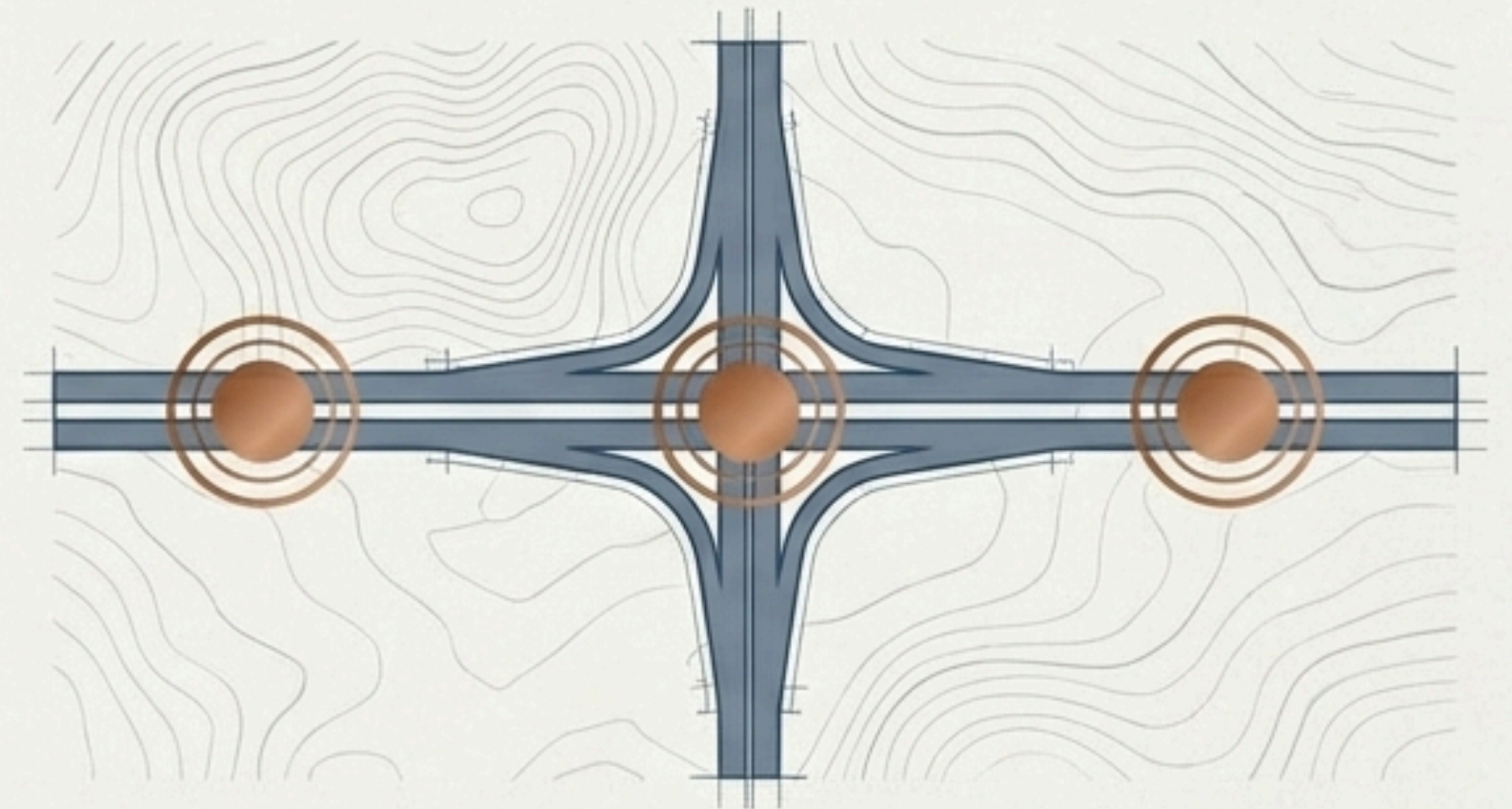
The Echo Phase:

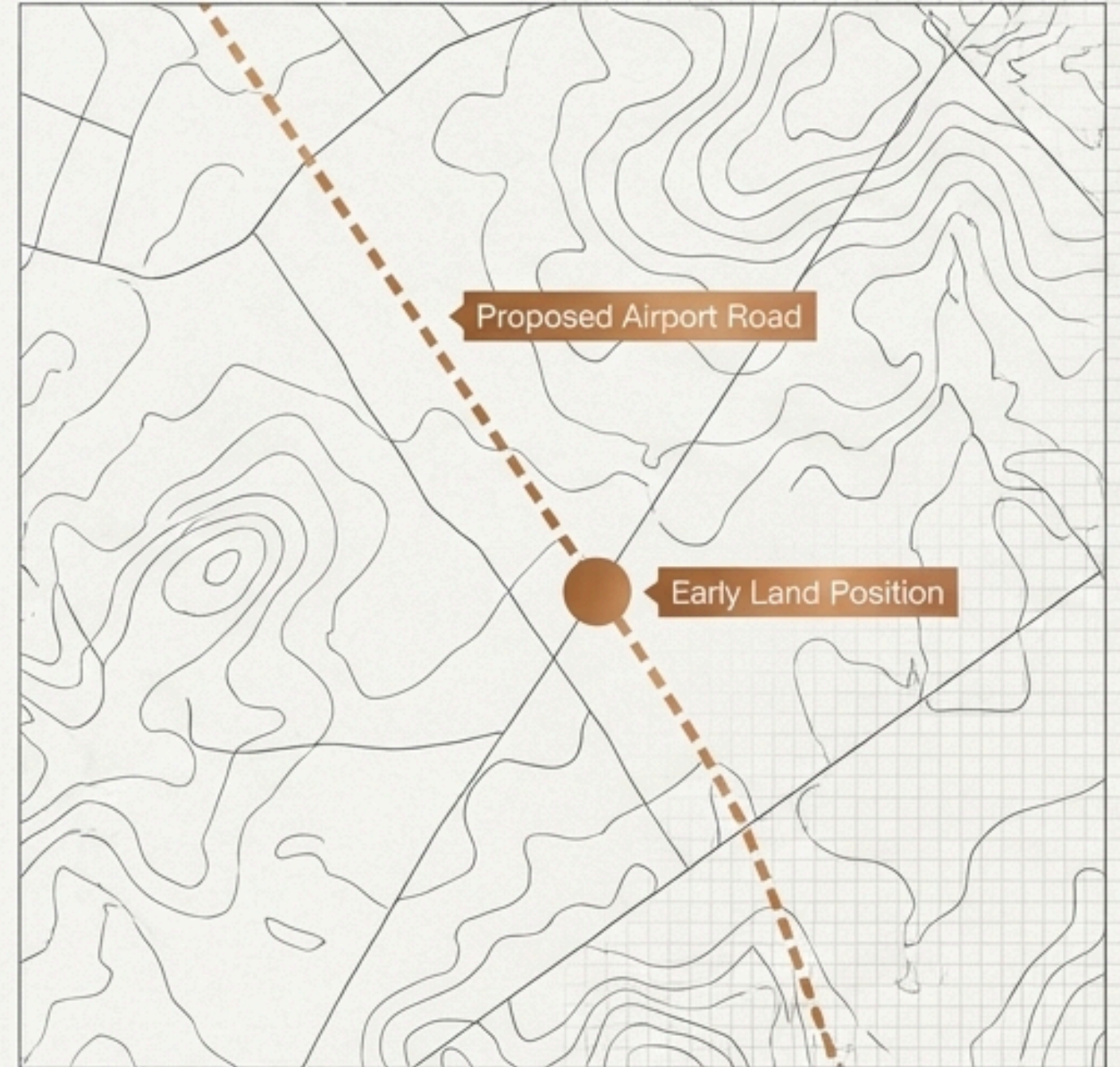

Historical Proof: The Mohali Corridor

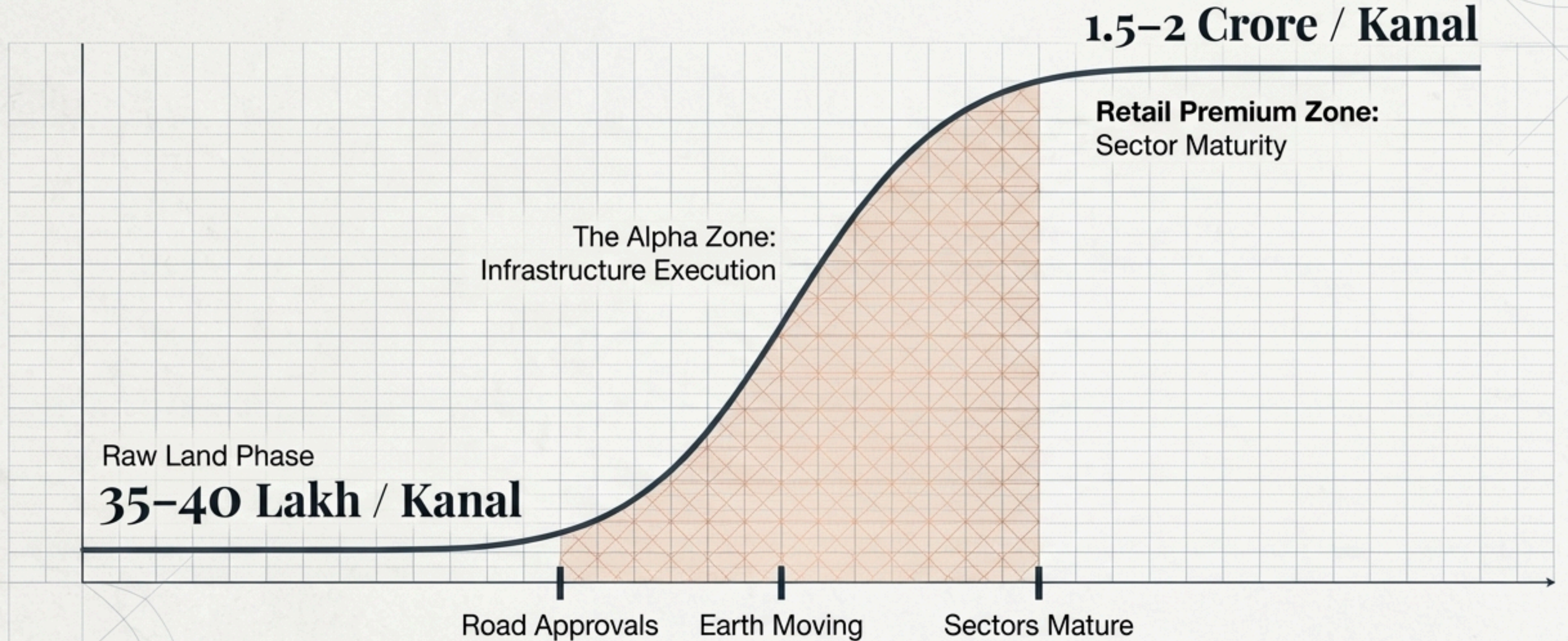
Before Airport Road became Mohali's major growth corridor, the surrounding raw land belts were entirely ignored by the retail crowd.

The baseline valuation per kanal when only visionary capital was paying attention.



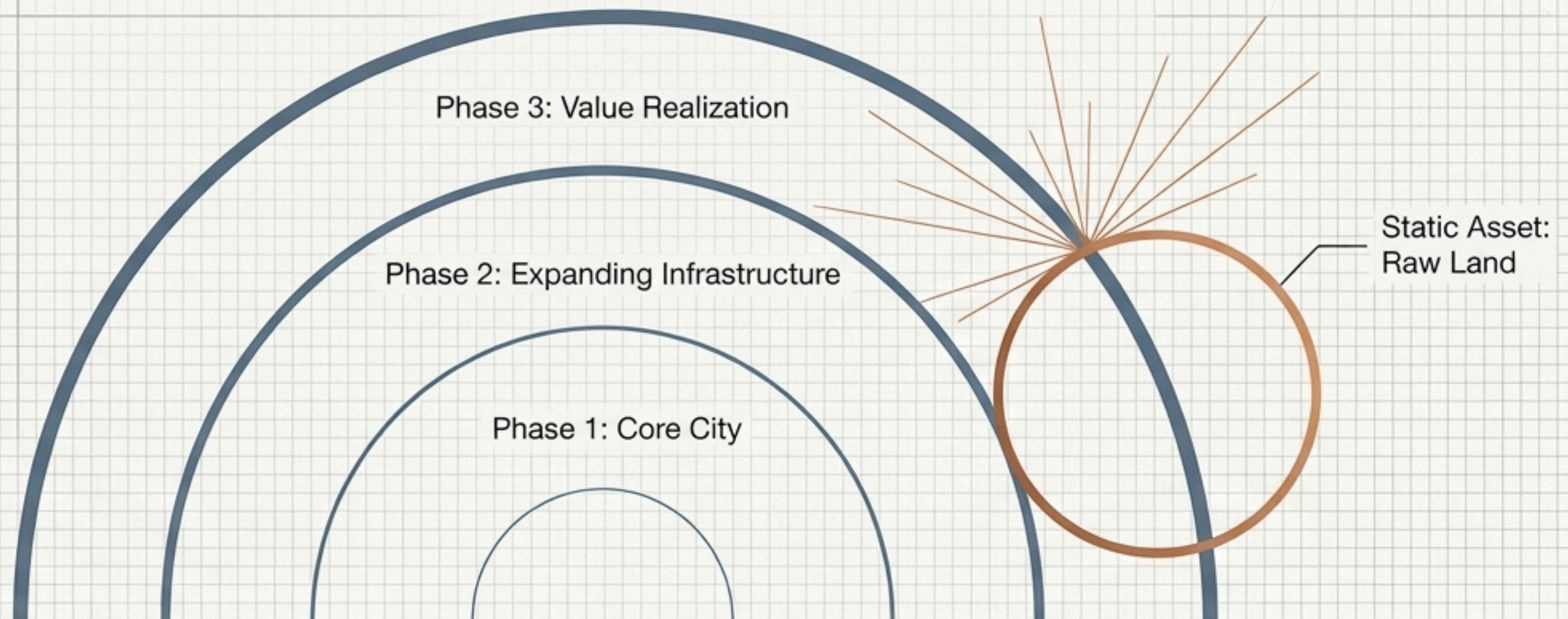
The Value Realization Curve

The Ultimate Question

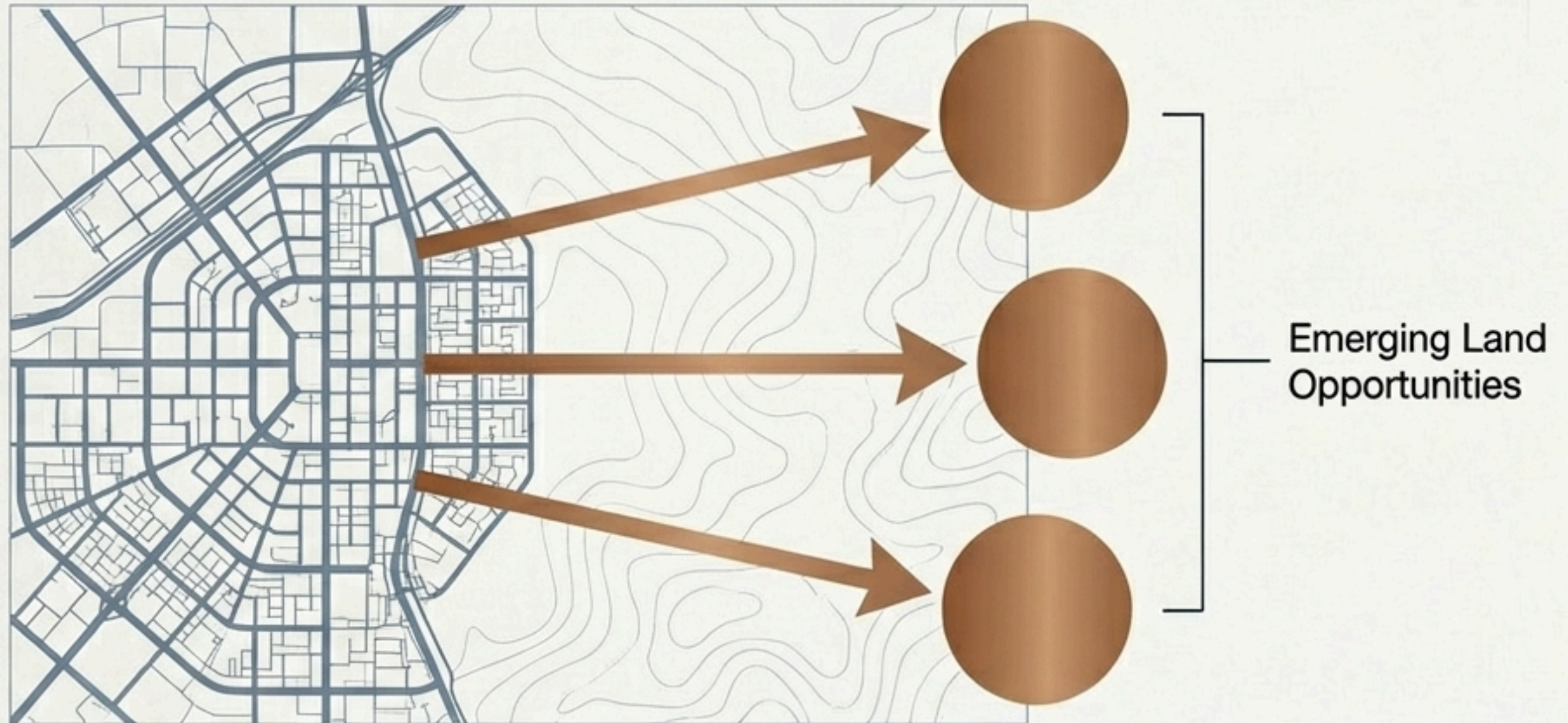
